CHILD DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Many efforts are being made by the institution for the development and participation of children. In which 10 child stages has been formed in the field of work to make children aware of all their rights. With those child stage to empower child stage through various activities like Bal Kit, Mobile Library, Drama Workshop, child festival , Exposure, Summer Camp, Rally, My Wall, Rally, Slogan Writing, Regular Meeting, Training, Children Bank etc. Attempt is being made. So that children can get a platform to speak.



WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

For the purpose of women empowerment and group formation helpful in the activities of the farmers, the organization empowered rural and poor women by organizing rural women self-help groups, sitting, elections, invocation, exposure, women's day, Sakhi Saath Nibhana program and organizing various trainings Attempt is being made to do. So that rural women can become self-sufficient and ensure their participation in society for economic and social development.



CHILD EDUCATION PROGRAM

To link 6-14 year old children to education, by constituting, managing and regular meeting of 07 schools in the jurisdiction under the Right to Education Act, empowering SMC to advocate enrolment, stay and quality education of children was attempted. In order to connect the education-deprived children with education, a network of surveyors, guardians, education meetings, home visits and service providers were made for 120 children in 3 months in 2017 in collaboration with 5 Non-Residential Campus Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan. In 2018, a 2 month non-residential camp was started in Kalbeliya Basti, Kazipura with the help of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan. Which was conducted with the joint efforts of the institution team and the local school management committee?



YOUTH AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

7 Teenager stage and 05 Youth stage were formed to empower the youth and youth on leadership and life skills. Efforts are being made to empower adolescents and youth by organizing various activities such as leadership, life skills, adolescent-age training, regular sitting, adolescent awakening week, sports, organization building, drug abuse, child labour, film shows, rallies etc.



ADOLESCENT GIRLS PROGRAM

For the purpose of empowering adolescent girls, in the field of work, formation of 06 teenage groups, orientation, training, life skills and self-defense, regular sitting, exposure, girls Kabaddi team, friendship week, etc., by taking various activities out of the homes, educating them, education, health, Efforts are being made to create awareness about cleanliness, child marriage and girl education.



SUMMER CAMP

To provide a fun and safe environment for camper's ages 6-14 years old to acquire new skills and build friendships through activities designed to develop creativity, confidence, and character. Through camps, we believe we can provide an opportunity for personal growth, increased self-esteem, and friendships that will last a lifetime.
